
REV. LUTIMOTHY MAY SR



REV. LUTIMOTHY MAY SR., M. DIV., a native of Pensacola, Florida, has served in pastoral leadership for 25 years, currently serving as Senior Pastor and Overseer. He was blessed with the gifts of teaching, preaching, singing, and speaking. His humble spirit and commitment to Christ are evident in his daily life.

Rev. May has received several awards and degrees, culminating in a Master of Divinity Degree from Morehouse School of Religion at the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Ga (2005). He also received an Honorary Doctoral Degree from the Kingdom Vessels Christian Bible Institute and Seminary (2013). He has served on over 20 civic and governmental boards throughout Florida, including the gubernatorial appointment to the University of West Florida Board of Trustees. He's advocated for better access to affordable and quality health care while serving 5 years on the Baptist Hospital Board of Directors. He has served as co-chair of Pensacola's first strong mayor transition team. Partnering with Navy Federal Credit Union, Baptist Hospital, Innisfree Hotels, and the City of Pensacola, He spearheaded Pensacola's most significant jobs and career day.

Rev May's commitment to education has led him to impact learning at multiple stages, including adjunct instructor and assistant director of student support services at the University of West Florida and founding the Dixon School of the Arts, a K-8 private school geared to help bridge the achievement gap of systemically disenfranchised students within the Escambia County School District. 2014 He founded an early Childhood learning development center on the Church's campus.

He is the 5th and youngest pastor to serve, succeeding his father, who served 38 years before passing in 2006. Rev. May took the roughly 45-member congregation and grew to over 1500 members. The unprecedented growth of the Church was accommodated through 3 Sunday services and several weekly services. He led the Church into its most significant move in 2013 by acquiring a 65,000 sq ft Church Campus with four buildings and a beautiful sanctuary with a double balcony, increasing the Church's assets value to 10 million. As of this year, He proudly gives God all the glory for the Church, which is free and clear of all mortgages!
