

PASTOR BRANDON D. WALKER

BIOGRAPHY



Pastor Brandon D. Walker is on a God-given mission to provide ministry for every stage of life ministering to meet the needs of all individuals while operating in the spirit of excellence.

Brandon was born and raised in Jonesboro, Arkansas. He graduated from Jonesboro High School and from Arkansas State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Human Resource Management. Upon completing the requirements for the Master of Ministry degree, Walker graduated from Harding University of Searcy, Arkansas.

Minister Brandon Walker began directing church choirs at the tender age of 8 and received Jesus as Lord at the age of 10 at the Saint John Missionary Baptist Church where he was baptized. At the age of 11 through God's unique gifting, Minister Walker became a musician and went on to lead several local, state, and regional choirs. In 1998, Walker accepted his calling to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and was ordained in 2002.

Pastor Brandon Walker was elected as pastor of the First Baptist Church of Wynne, Arkansas, at the age of 23. Under his administration, more than 70 people were added to the church and new ministries were established.

In 2005, he answered the call to become the undershepherd of the Saint John Missionary Baptist Church of Jonesboro, Arkansas. During his tenure, over 600 decisions were made for Christ resulting in massive growth of the church.

Walker began his third pastorate at the New Shelby Missionary Baptist Church of Collierville, Tennessee. Under Walker's administration, New Shelby was blessed with the addition of new audio/visual equipment and carpeting for the sanctuary and to repave the parking lot. Pastor B was instrumental in creating a capital campaign to liquidate the debt of the church's life center and burning of its mortgage. Three new deacons were ordained also to serve the growing vision of the church.

Pastor Walker was very active in the community serving the greater Memphis area. He served as the Project Director for Council for a Strong America based out of Washington DC which helped secure funds from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation that were used for teacher development throughout Shelby County.

Reverend Walker is also active in district work as a certified instructor. Pastor Walker has taught classes on the local, state, and regional level within the Baptist denomination and has served as President of the Congress of Christian Education for the Zion District Association in Memphis, Tennessee. He currently serves as Dean for the Galilee Griggs Memorial District Association of Churches in Dallas, Texas.

In December 2021, the Walkers relocated to Dallas, Texas. Shortly after, Pastor B accepted a new assignment to serve as Senior Pastor. In less than 2 years post-pandemic, Walker has experienced a fresh wind of God's grace resulting in rapid growth of the congregation, 23 baptisms, and the ordination of 5 deacons.

Brandon and his wife, Lady Nicole, share four children together. Nicole is a registered nurse and works for one of Texas' most prestigious hospitals, Baylor, Scott, and White, where she serves as a Healthcare Administrator. As a couple, their greatest desire is to live out the kingdom of God and leave a legacy in the earth.
